### Formation of Classes

A minimum of ten (10) entrants to face the starter or the class may be withdrawn.

### Grid Capacity

Maximum number of karts per each event is 40.

### Points System

401 less 10%  
Points for all classes and all heats will tally for series.  
Non finishers awarded points based on position at last lap completed.  
Non starters will receive zero points.  
Final only counts.

### Transponders

AMB Tranx 160 transponders will be used throughout the event.  
**Personal transponders must be used. Please include your AMB Tranx seven digit number on the AKA scrutineering form and confirm this number at entry confirmation.**

**Method of Racing****Under Subscribed Classes**

Heats 1 & 2 – 8 laps, Pre-final – 10 laps, Final – 12 Laps

Pre-drawn grid for Heat 1. Reverse grid for Heat 2.

Combined points from heats will determine grid position for the Pre-final.

Finishing order of Pre-Final determines grid position for the Final.

**Final only counts on the day****Over-subscribed classes:****Heats 1 & 2 – 8 Laps, Pre-final - 10 Laps, Final - 12 Laps**

Class will split into two groups of even quantity groups A & B

Pre-drawn grid for 1<sup>st</sup> Heat. Reverse grid for 2<sup>nd</sup> Heat for the two groups

A. Heat 1 ( Group A)

B. Heat 1 ( Group B)

C. Heat 2 ( Group A)

D. Heat 2 ( Group B)

Only the **Top forty ( 40 )** placed competitors to progress to finals.

Grid positions for Pre- Final are based on the points gained during the 2 Heats. Driver with the highest points to grid 1, next to grid 2 and so on up to track capacity, compete in the Pre Final. Drivers with equal points up to track capacity, grid positions will be determined by highest points finishing position.

Finishing order of pre final determines grid position for the final

**Final only counts on the day.****Prizes**

Trophies are awarded for 1, 2, 3 placegetters.

All Star Series prizes of a Yamaha Engine and set of Tyres for each class will be via a random draw for all drivers.

Drivers must complete all four rounds to be eligible to go in the draw.

Each class must have 12 starters at each round for the prize to be applicable.

Trophies awarded to 1, 2, 3 place getters at completion of the series at the VKA Presentation Night on 11 December 2010 (Venue TBA).

**Blue & Red Double Diagonal Flag**

The Blue and Red Double Diagonal Flag WILL be used during this meeting.
