7. Minimum Entries – 6 per class. If insufficient entries are received for a class, classes may be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the Organizer. (A,B,C & Provisional D grade drivers are eligible to enter)

8. Format of Racing: - Clockwise Direction – 855 mtrs / Capacity 32
2 Heats of 8 laps – (draw, reverse draw) – Final of 10 laps – (Highest points to front)
401 less 10% - points awarded for DNF (field plus one position)
Final Only Counts = Class Winner on the day. Series Classes - points from Rd1 & 2 are accumulative.

10. Mechanical Breakdown Lane will not be in use. (R17.10)

11. Blue & Red Double Diagonal Flag will not be used during this meeting. (R15.13)

12. Abandonment or Postponement (R11.09)

The organizers reserve the right at their sole discretion to abandon, postpone or cancel any event(s).

13. Prizes Trophies will be awarded to 1st / 2nd / 3rd placegetters of each class for the day.
Trophy presentation as per Rule 11.10 (a,b,c) subject to official confirmation & completion of Technical Inspections

14. Insurance has been affected for this meeting in accordance with Chapter 3.

15. Noise Levels maximum permissible noise levels shall be in accordance with Chapter 24.

16. Fuel – Chapter 22 PULP fuel is available in Swan Hill.

17. Judges of Fact: (R4.17)

The Starter / The Chief Lap Scorer / The Scales Marshall / The Grid Marshall./The Chief Scrutineer.

18. Kart Numbers must be clearly & correctly displayed at all times – Rule 19.08 / Rule 25.13 i ii iii iv vii
Also, when there is a double up of *race* numbers in *any* class / combination, the Race Secretary's decision will be final

19. Pit Crew ID All Pit Crew *must* have & display their pass or wristband for entry to grids / parc ferme.

20. Pit Crew – ‘Personal’ Yellow Safety Vest – *must* be worn in the grid, parc ferme & track area at all times.
A high Viz green jumper or shirt is acceptable. (Ruling 18th Feb VKA Council meeting, Effective March 2010)

21. Engine Sealing will be done at this meeting.

22. Exhaust Sealing for Midgets & Rookies sealing nuts are required (R40.06 / R41.27)

23. Tyres (Chapter 23) tyre marking will be done at this meeting

24. Use of Open Flame is not permitted in the circuit, parc ferme, paddock / pit areas. (R17.14)

25. Camping Is Free and permitted **Only in Designated Area**

26. No Dogs / Animals are allowed in complex on race / practice days.

Background Note

Article 65 of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, under which all competitions will be conducted, sets out the information that should be included in the Supplementary Regulations.

These Supplementary Regulations are to be read in conjunction with the General Standing Regulations and the Australian Kart Formula for Sprint Racing as laid down in the Current AKA Manual.
