8. Minimum Entries

The minimum number of entries per class shall be 8 genuine entries. If insufficient entries are received for a class, classes may be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the organisers.

9. Format of Racing

3 Heats, 1 Final

Heat 1, 10 Laps on Saturday, Pre-drawn grid

Heat 2, 10 Laps on Saturday, Reverse grid of heat 1

Heat 3, 12 Laps on Sunday, Highest points to front.

Final, 20 Laps on Sunday, Accumulated points from heats determines starting position for final

Points System:

Heats: Point score system is 401 less 10%

Points awarded field +1 for DNF

DNS nil points awarded.

Final: Final only counts.

Please note: PERSONAL TRANSPONDERS ARE TO BE USED IN THIS EVENT AMB TRANX 160 transponders will be used throughout the event for all lapscoreing of heats and final. Personal transponders must be used.

Please include your AMB 7 digit number on the AKA scrutineering form, and confirm this number at entry confirmation.

12. Racing Numbers

Racing numbers must be displayed on the left hand side of the kart to assist lap scorers.

13. Fuel/Tyres

Tyres will be marked at this meeting

14. Flags

The blue and red double diagonal flag will not be used during this meeting. Refer Rule 15.13

15. Abandonment or Postponement

The organisers deserve the right at their sole discretion to abandon, postpone or cancel any event subject to Rule 11.09

16. Insurance

Insurance has been affected for this meeting in accordance with chapter 3

17. Noise Levels

Maximum permissible noise level shall be in accordance with chapter 24

18. Mechanical Breakdown Lane

Will not be in use at this meeting

19. Engine & Exhaust Sealing

Cylinder head and exhaust sealing nuts are required.

20. Pit Crew Passes

All pit crew will need to have a pit crew pass or wrist band to get onto the in or out grid areas.

21. Pit Area

Open sided tents are permitted in pit area at the pit marshal's discretion. The pit marshal's instructions must be adhered to.

22. General Information

Canteen will be open for breakfast Saturday and Sunday morning.

BBQ and Bar will be operating Saturday evening.
