Grid Capacity	Maximum number of karts per each event is 32.

Points System	<p>401 less 10%</p> <p>Points for all classes and all heats will tally for series.</p> <p>Non finishers awarded points based on position at last lap completed.</p> <p>Non starters will receive zero points.</p> <p>Final only counts.</p>
Transponders	<p>AMB Tranx 160 transponders will be used throughout the event for all timed practise and racing. Personal transponders must be used. Please include your AMB seven digit number on the AKA scrutineering form and confirm this number at entry confirmation.</p>
Method of Racing	<p><u>Under Subscribed Classes</u></p> <p>Heats 1 & 2 – 10 laps, Pre-final – 14 laps, Final – 16 Laps</p> <p>Pre-drawn grid for Heat 1. Reverse grid for Heat 2.</p> <p>Combined points from heats will determine grid position for the Pre-final.</p> <p>Finishing order of Pre-Final determines grid position for the Final.</p> <p><u>Final only counts on the day</u></p> <p><u>Over-subscribed classes:</u></p> <p>Heats 1 & 2 – 10 Laps, Pre-final - 14 Laps, Final - 16 Laps</p> <p>Class will split into two groups of even quantity groups A & B</p> <p>Pre-drawn grid for 1st Heat. Reverse grid for 2nd Heat for the two groups</p> <p>A. Heat 1 (Group A)</p> <p>B. Heat 1 (Group B)</p> <p>C. Heat 2 (Group A)</p> <p>D. Heat 2 (Group B)</p> <p>Only the Top thirty six (32) placed competitors to progress to finals.</p> <p>Grid positions for Pre- Final are based on the points gained during the 2 Heats. Driver with the highest points to grid 1, next to grid 2 and so on up to track capacity, compete in the Pre Final. Drivers with equal points up to track capacity, grid positions will be determined by highest points finishing position.</p> <p>Finishing order of pre final determines grid position for the final</p> <p>Final only counts on the day.</p>
Prizes	<p>Trophies are awarded for 1, 2, 3 placegetters.</p> <p>All Star Series prizes of a Yamaha Engine and set of Tyres for each class will be via a random draw for all drivers.</p> <p>Drivers must complete all four rounds to be eligible to go in the draw.</p> <p>Each class must have 12 starters at each round for the prize to be applicable.</p> <p>Trophies awarded to 1, 2, 3 placegetters at completion of the series at the VKA Presentation Night on 11 December 2010 (Venue TBA).</p>
Blue & Red Double Diagonal Flag	<p>The Blue and Red Double Diagonal Flag WILL be used during this meeting.</p>
Weights / Fuel / Tyres	<p>As per 2010 AKA Manual and Amendments.</p> <p>Download the 2010 Manual - http://www.vka.asn.au/notice.asp?id=130</p>
Pit Crew Passes / Vests	<p>All pit crew need to have a pit crew pass or wristband and have your own high visibility yellow/green vest or clothing to get onto the In Grid and/or Out Grid and any other areas of the track requiring their use.</p>
Track Closure	<p>The track will be closed to all entrants for practise from Monday, 12 July to Thursday, 15 July INCLUSIVE.</p> <p>Gates will be open on Friday, 16 July for unofficial practise and pit set-up.</p>

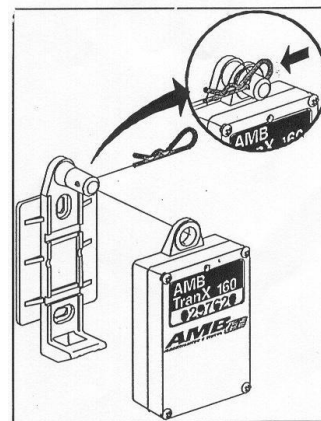
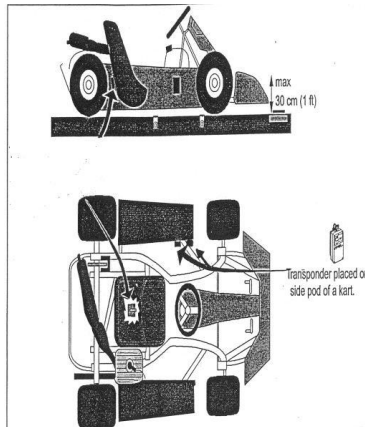
Scrutineering

Smoking or welding is not allowed in the designated pit areas
Dumping of fuel is not permitted
No animals are allowed on OGKRC property (registered Guide and Assistance dogs excepted)
No bikes, scooters, skateboards, rollerblades permitted – they will be confiscated for the duration of the meeting.
Camping is not permitted
Hire marquees are not to be erected without the knowledge and approval of OGKRC
It is a condition of entry to display sponsor decals on karts as directed by the promoters.
