8. Format of Racing

2 heats of 10 Laps. Final of 15 Laps,

1st heat – computer draw, 2nd heat – reverse of heat 1 draw, Final - grid positions will be highest points to the front and so on. All points will count. 401 point system will be used to determine class placing.

16. Fuel. (Refer Rule 22.01) Random samples of competitor's fuel will be taken during this meeting and tested for conformity.

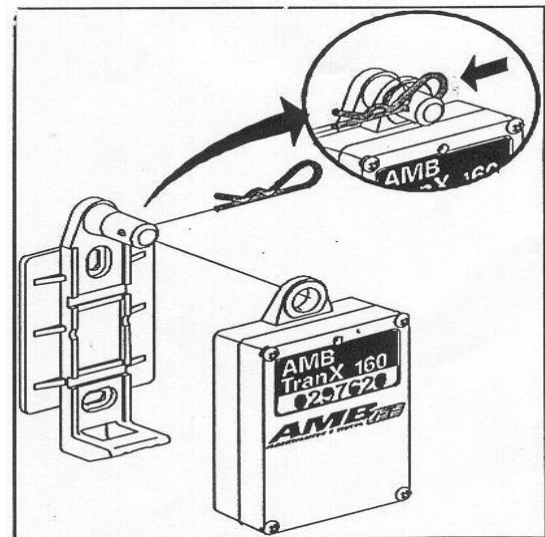
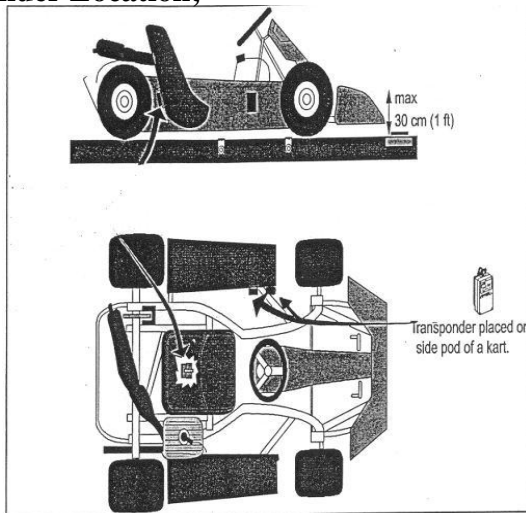
