### **Minimum Entries - 6 genuine entries**

If there are insufficient entries to constitute a class by the listed close of entries, the class will **NOT** be contested and may be combined with another class or cancelled at the discretion of the Organisers.

## **FORMAT OF RACING**

**Method of Racing:** Anticlockwise.  
Maximum number of starters per class: 24.

**Three (3) heats** To be run over, 10 Laps.  
Heats 1 & 2 – Draw and Reverse Draw.  
Heat 3 Highest Points to Pole.

**One (1) Final** To be run over, 12 Laps.  
Grid position determined by Highest Points to Pole.

***All points count to determine winner.***

**Points Score System:** 401 less 10% System.

**Non Finishers – (DNF)** awarded finishing points based on the numbers in the class,  
plus 1 place.

**Non Starters – (DNS)** no points awarded.

## **Trophies:**

Trophies will be presented for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place for each class.

**A trophy will be awarded for the “P Plate driver” gaining the Highest Points in each class.**

Trophy Presentation – As per Rule 11.10 (a,b,c,) subject to official confirmation and completion of technical inspections. Official notices will be posted.

## **PERSONAL TRANSPONDERS**

**ALL COMPETITORS MUST HAVE A PERSONAL TRANSPONDER – AMB TRANX 160 FITTED TO THEIR KART. Refer RULE 19.17 a (1), b. - WILL BE USED FOR LAP SCORING ONLY. PLEASE RECORD YOUR AMB SEVEN DIGIT NUMBER ON THE AKA SCRUTINEERING FORM WHEN CONFIRMING YOUR ENTRY.**

## **Mechanical Breakdown Lane:**

The mechanical breakdown lane **will not be in use**, under rule 17.10.

## **Blue and Red double diagonal Flag:**

The blue and red double diagonal flag **will not be used**, during this meeting. Refer Rule 15.13

## **Engine Sealing:**

- ◆ Sealing nuts **must** be fitted on the cylinder head of **all** engines. Yamaha KT100S engines require an internal hex cylindrical nut. Refer Rule 19.33 . 9.2
- ◆ Midget & Rookies Yamaha engines **must be fitted with (2)** exhaust header sealing nuts in addition to cylinder head nuts. (Refer Rule 40.0 6 & Rule 41.27)
- ◆ Comer engines exhaust and cowl cap screws **MUST** be drilled for sealing.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

No animals allowed. No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit. No motorised scooters, scooters, mini bikes, bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the event.

### **Trailers / Cars:      No vehicles are permitted in Pit Area**

Pit space 3m x 3m only.

All vehicles are to be parked in designated parking areas allocated.
