CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Eligibility is limited to drivers who are holders of a current A, B or C Grade KA licence. D grade or provisional licence holders are not eligible to enter. Refusal or acceptance of entries is in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 17. The promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel any event as in accordance with the Rules. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

If less than **8** genuine entries are received to constitute a Class by the listed close of entries then the Class may NOT be contested. All drivers whose entry is not accepted for any Class shall be notified as soon as possible and entry fee will be returned.

1st, 2nd & 3rd in each Class. Blue plates will be awarded for winners of each Class.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

KART RETRIEVAL:

Pit Crew with trolleys will NOT be given access to the Track during Qualifying and Racing. Retrieval is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Track when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a **HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST** in accordance with the Rules.

Karts can be retrieved via access through the Out Grid only.

INSURANCE:

Has been affected for this Meeting in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 3 of the 2020 KA Manual.

SCRUTINEERING:

Scrutineering for this Meeting will be in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the KA Manual.

In accordance with the provisions of the Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the 2020 KA Manual, each Kart shall have affixed to it a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark supplied for the Meeting. This signifies that the Driver has confirmed their entry for the Meeting and completed a Scrutineering Form relevant to the Entry.

As from 3/04/2020, the Grid Marshal/Scrutineers will not allow any Kart that does not display a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark to Practice, Qualify or Race. Failure to comply will result in the Driver being excluded from the Meeting.

FRONT FAIRING (Technical Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 8 g) (iii):

The Front Fairing Fitment Rules Will be used at this Meeting.

ENGINE SEALING AND CHASSIS TAGGING:

Each engine and Chassis must be sealed and tagged in accordance with the provisions of Technical Rules, Chapter 6.

RESTRICTORS:

KA4 Junior Light and Heavy Drivers must ensure that their engine is fitted with a Type 2 D19 Exhaust Manifold Restrictor.

KA4 Rotors

KA4 Junior Light and Heavy Drivers must ensure that their engine is fitted with a type 'R' Rotor as supplied by Remo Racing

TIMING TRANSPONDER FITTING INSTRUCTIONS:

MYLAPS compatible transponders must be mounted in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 8 i)

Note: All Karts **MUST** have fitted and correctly charged and operating transponders for all sessions commencing 3/04/2020

VIDEO RECORDING SYSTEMS - Recording Medium (SD Card) Procedures

- It is compulsory for all Competitors to have a camera fitted to their Kart in a working condition from the start of the first practice session at this Meeting. Failure to do so will result in exclusion from the next practice session. In the event of it being the final session a \$200 fine will be imposed.
- A separate SD Card must be used for each Championship Class contested at a Meeting.
- Prior to the commencement of on-track activity on each day of a Round, the Recording Medium used in the camera fitted to a Kart must be completely cleared and reformatted.
- No recorded vision on the Recording Medium may be deleted from the time that on-track activity has commenced on each day of a Meeting until 0700 hours the next day, without the prior written permission of the Stewards.
