METHOD OF RACING

QUALIFYING	One 8 minute section
HEATS	2 x 10 Laps
Pre-final	1 x 12 Laps
Final	1 x 16 laps

- Fastest timed lap from Qualifying to Pole for Heats 1 & 2 and so on
- Total accumulated points from Heats 1 & 2 will determine the Grid positions for Pre-final
- Finishing order for the Pre-final determines positions for the Final
- Finishing order of the Final, determines the winning positions of the Class

Points System

- Zero Point System for Heats
 - 1st O Points / 2nd 2 Points / 3rd 3 Points and so on with one point added for each place
- Non starters and non-finishers to be awarded a finishing position based on the number of laps completed + 1 position. If less
 than 1 lap completed, then the grid position awarded from the start of Heat and or Pre-final + 1 position.

PRIZES:

Will be awarded in accordance with the provisions of Competitions Rules, Chapter 5 Rule 4 r). Trophies will be awarded for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} place for each Class on the final day of the Meeting.

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

MECHANICAL BREAKDOWN LANE: (Refer General Rules, Chapter 4 Rule 11):

The Mechanical Breakdown lane will not be in use at this Meeting.

KART RETRIEVAL:

Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Timed Practise and Racing.

Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshall and then only if wearing a high visibility safety vest on the upper torso.

Karts can be retrieved via access through the In/Out Grid.

INSURANCE

Has been effected for this Meeting in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 3 of the 2016 KA Manual.

SCRUTINEERING:

Scrutineering for this Meeting will be in accordance with the provisions of the Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the KA Manual. In accordance with the provisions of the Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the 2016 KA Manual, each Kart shall have affixed to it a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark supplied for the Meeting. This signifies that the driver has confirmed their entry for the Meeting and completed a Scrutineering Form relevant to the entry.

The Grid Marshall / Scrutineers will not permit any kart that does not display a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark to enter the Race Track to Practise or Race.

ENGINE SEALING AND CHASSIS TAGGING:

Each engine must be sealed and each Chassis must be tagged in accordance with the provisions of Technical Rules, Chapter 6.

CONTROL FUEL:

In accordance with the provisions of the Technical Rules, Chapter 3, Control Fuel will be used for this Meeting and can only be purchased from:

- (i) Fuel Brand: Shell
- (ii) Fuel Type: PULP is the only fuel permitted
- (iii) Service Station Name: Shell Service Centre Westgate
- (iv) Service Station Address: Shell Service Centre, 12-62 Cook Street, Port Melbourne 3207
- (v) Competitors in all Classes must use the Control Fuel
- (vi) Fuel for the Meeting can be purchased from Thursday 11th August 2016 to Sunday 14th August 2016.
 - *Proof of purchase receipts must be retained and produced to the State Technical Officer as and when required.
- (vii) Control Fuel MUST be used from 9am Friday 12th August to until the conclusion of the Meeting.

Random samples of Competitor's fuel may be taken during the Meeting and tested for conformity to samples of the Control Fuel taken from the supplier on these dates. Competitors are reminded that fuel tanks and drums should be empty prior to be used for fuel purchased for this Meeting. No dumping of fuel is permitted on site.







TIMING AND LAP SCORING RECORDING:

Will be conducted in accordance with Competition Rules, Chapter 5 Rule 4 j).

TYRE POOLING: (Technical Rules, Chapter 4 Rule 5).

Tyre pooling will not occur at this meeting.

All competitors are required to have Barcoded Tyres for this meeting. Race tyres must be presented for scanning before qualifying at the appropriate time or as directed by officials.

If an Event is declared "Wet", Competitors will be required to present Wet Weather Tyres for scanning or marking as directed by the Officials.

VEHICLE / TRAILER ACCESS:

No Vehicles will be allowed in Pit Area / Trailers or vehicle designation to be arranged through the Club Officer by email to – secretary@gkcv.com.au

The Pit Area will be locked each night between 8pm and 6am.
