<b>5.1.</b>	Qualifying	One Qualifying Session of 6 minutes				
<b>5.2.</b>	Heats	There will be <b>3 heats</b> . The Grid for Heat 1 will be set from times achieved in Qualifying, with fastest time on grid 1, and so on.				
<b>5.3.</b>		The Grid for Heat 2 will be set from times achieved in qualifying.				
<b>5.4.</b>		The Grid for Heat 3 will be set from points achieved in heats 1 and 2 Highest to the front				
<b>5.5.</b>	Pre-final	The grid for the Pre-final will be set from points achieved in the previous 3 heats Highest to the front				
<b>5.6.</b>	Final	The grid for the Pre-final will be set from Points achieved in the previous heats and pre final highest to the front. TOTAL OVERALL POINTS DETERMINES THE PLACINGS ON THE DAY
